Overview:

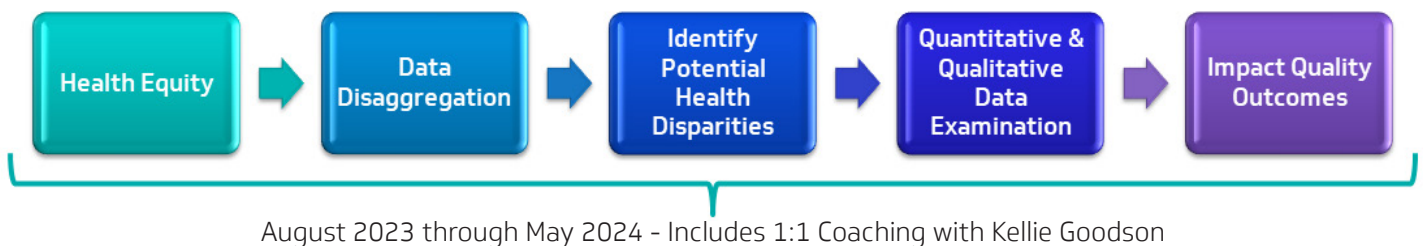
